

## Bill of Rights for Children of Separation and Divorce

## Every child has:

1. the right to be free from violence and abuse

- 2. the right to have a safe and stable environment
  - 3. the right to express love to both parents
- 4. the right not to be placed in the position of message carrier
  - 5. the right not to be asked to be the family spy
  - 6. the right not to be told negative information about their parent or parent's family
  - 7. the right not to be interrogated after a visit with the other parent
    - 8. the right to express or not to express his or her own feelings
  - 9. the right not to be exposed to conflict with the other parent
    - 10. the right to remain a child and not a parent confidant
    - 11. the right to be told about family changes, such as moving house or contact arrangements
    - 12. the right to be connected to both parents' families, if safe
- 13. the right not to be responsible for their parents' separation or divorce
  14. the right to be loved unconditionally
