

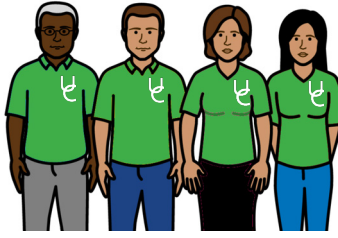

We help people with the NDIS.

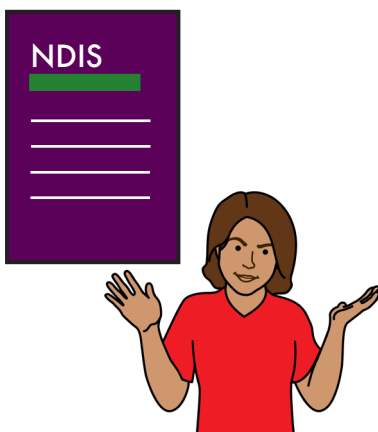
We call this our Disability Advocacy Service.

We may help you

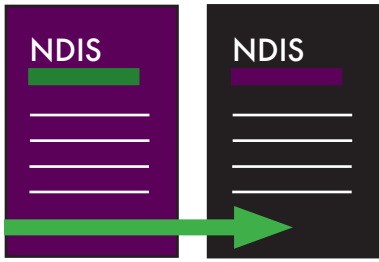
- apply for the NDIS

- ask to review your NDIS plan.



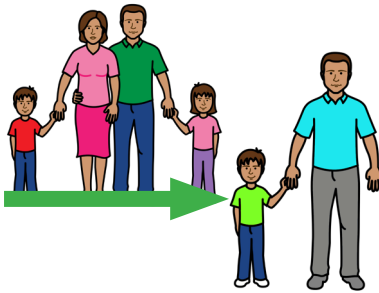
You may have a problem with your NDIS plan.

- do **not** have enough money for things you need.

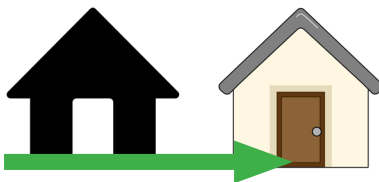


You may need to change your NDIS plan.

There are lots of ways to meet with us. Like

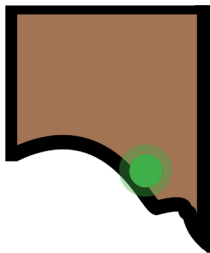
- on the phone
